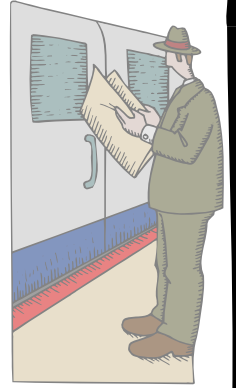
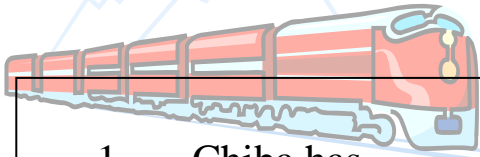


# What does "Public Transport" mean?

## **For Teachers**
