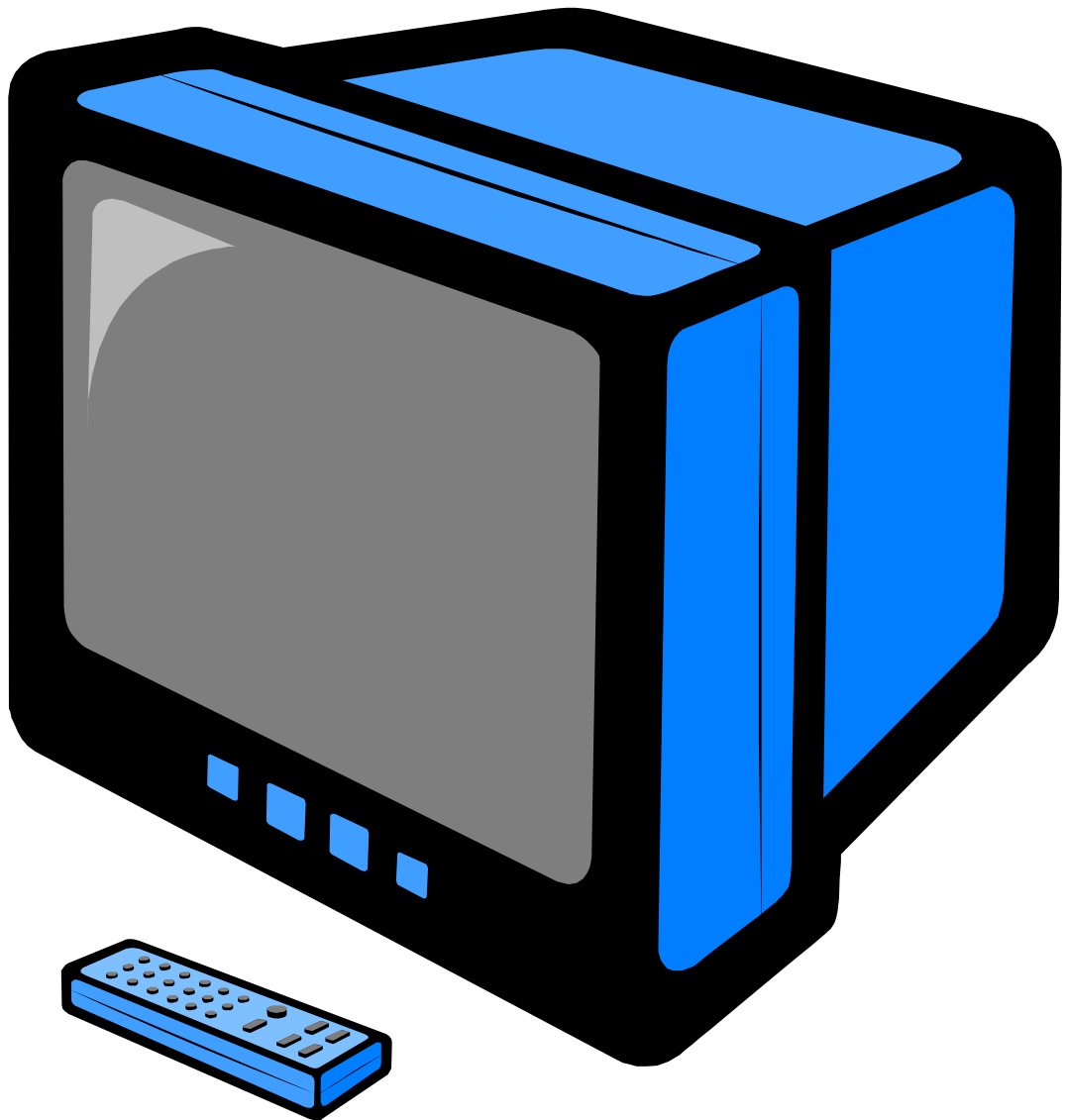

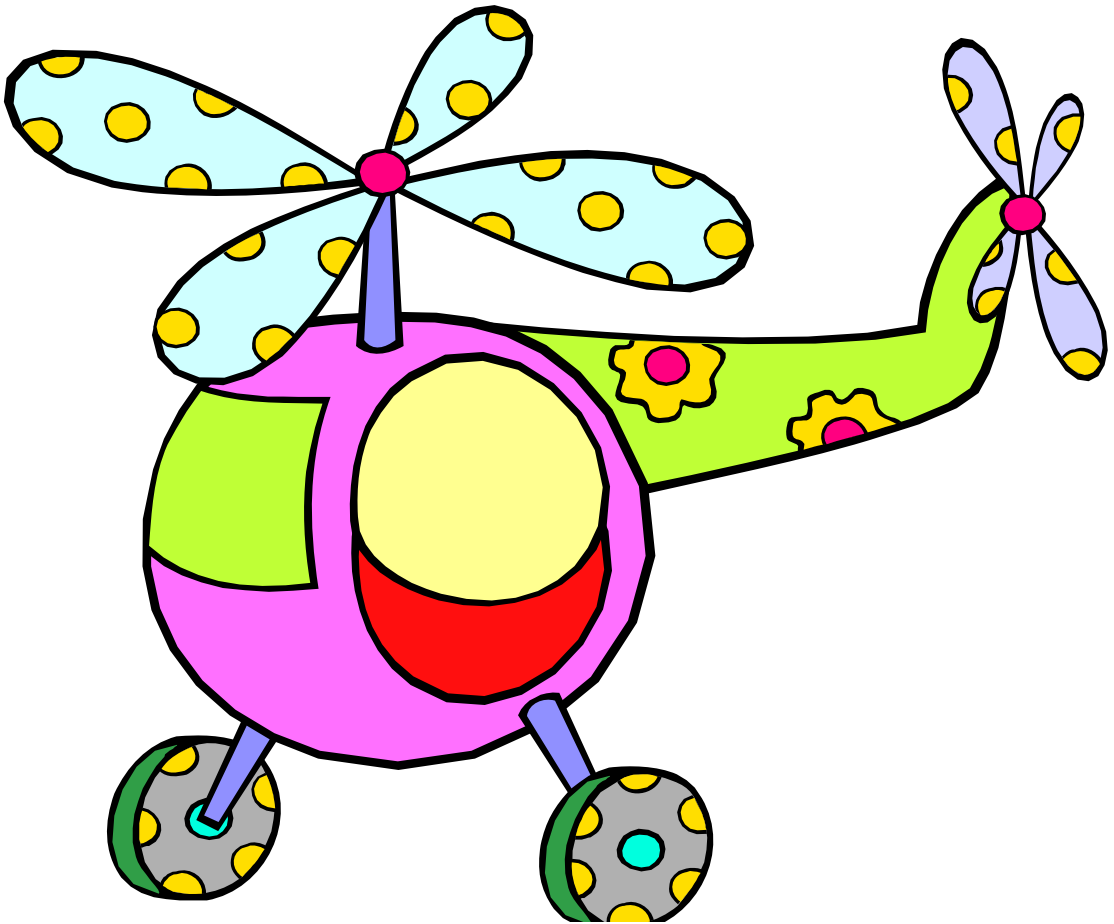
Handsome, intelligent, smart,
