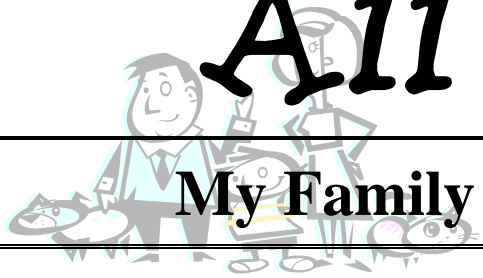

## For Teachers

As a final project for comparisons have the students write about both their family and their neighborhood. For the case of neighborhood have the students talk about where they live and where they would like to live and the reasons behind that decision. For the family they can talk about their brothers and sisters if they have any and compare those members to themselves. Remember that when comparing yourself to your family, or comparing your family members you can talk about both appearance and personality.

Before doing this project have the students fill in the worksheet on public transport to give them an idea of using different types of sentences to say the same thing. Then have an example written by yourself about your life so that the students have a frame of reference as to how they are supposed to write.

When using these worksheets in your class be aware that they are the worksheets that I used in my class printed here as is and as such use vocabulary and grammar appropriate to the students that I was teaching at the time. If you plan to use this or any other sheet in your class make sure that you have pre-taught all the vocabulary necessary or preferably, use the ideas here and rewrite the worksheet for your specific students needs.
