For Teachers

First the students fill the squares with the items in the pictures, preferably writing in the words but for younger students drawing the pictures may be OK. This game is challenging, you have to have the item in the correct room to be able to cross it off, and therefore for this game have the students choose items that they think should go in each room. Then go round the class and the students use the dialogue at the bottom of the page to ask the questions to find out what items can be crossed off.

If you are playing this game with a large number of students then you could have the class fill in the squares completely randomly. That will make the game last a little longer.

When using these worksheets in your class be aware that they are the worksheets that I used in my class printed here as is and as such use vocabulary and grammar appropriate to the students that I was teaching at the time. If you plan to use this or any other sheet in your class make sure that you have pre-taught all the vocabulary necessary or preferably, use the ideas here and rewrite the worksheet for your specific students needs.
