# For Teachers

Use these cards as you desire, they could be prompts for asking questions or part of a bingo or board game.

I used them as a gestures game and also as a game where you have two or three teams depending on class size and each team has a color. On the board you draw a 5X5 grid and randomly write down the letter A – Z leaving out 1 letter. Students then choose a letter, then one person from the team has to pick one card and then gesture to the rest of their team what is on the card. If their team can guess it right in 15 seconds the letter that they chose on the board turns to the color of their team. If they can't get the answer then that card is finished but the square stays blank. If one team get three in a row get five points and if they get four in a row 10 points, 5 in a row 15 points and for every place where one more square would give them extra points is a plus one point situation.

When using these worksheets in your class be aware that they are the worksheets that I used in my class printed here as is and as such use vocabulary and grammar appropriate to the students that I was teaching at the time. If you plan to use this or any other sheet in your class make sure that you have pre-taught all the vocabulary necessary or preferably, use the ideas here and rewrite the worksheet for your specific students needs.
