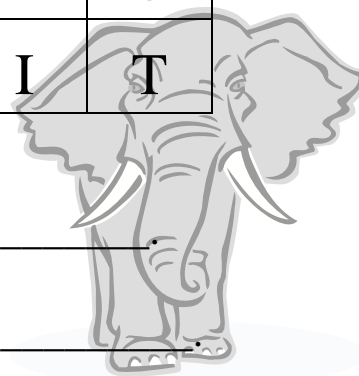

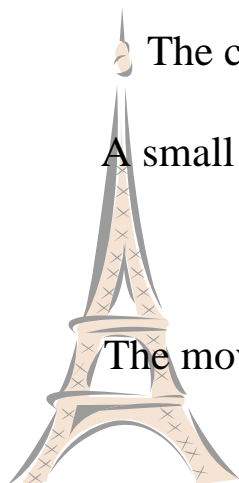

For Teachers

Another variation on the relative pronoun theme.

Again, get the students to fill in the words in the sentences below the table first and then have them look for the words in the grid.

Depending on how much time you want to spend on this worksheet you could either do the word search in the class or set it for homework.

Whenever you have this kind of word search activity, for checking purposes it's best to have an answer sheet printed up for the students, too. If you are teaching to a big class, checking the answer on the board is a little challenging.

Again, as I say about many of my worksheets, if you plan on using them in the class 'as is' you should make sure that your class has been pre-taught all of the appropriate vocabulary.

If the students aren't aware of some of the vocabulary or you think that some of the sentences may be a little hard for the students either do them specifically as a class, get the higher-level students to explain the meanings or preferably re-make the worksheet with the vocabulary that you have been teaching.
